We are excited to introduce the new President of the Southern African HIV Clinicians Society (SAHCS), Dr Ndiviwe Mphothulo.

Dr Mphothulo is a HIV Clinician with over 20 years' experience. He obtained his undergraduate medical degree from the Medical University of South Africa in 2001 (now Sefako Makgatho Health Sciences University) followed by a master's in public health in 2009. He then went on to do a Diploma in HIV Management in 2012, and a master's in business leadership in 2014.
