### FREE HEALTH CARE

#### **SERVICES IN SOUTH AFRICA:**

The Gauteng High Court confirmed that all pregnant and lactating women, and children under six, can access free health services at all public health facilities, including hospitals, irrespective of nationality and documentation status.

#### Who does it apply to?

- ALL pregnant women
- ALL women who are lactating
- · ALL children below the age of six

# Irrespective of nationality and documentation status



#### Who is not eligible?

- · People who are on medical aid
- And foreign nationals who come to South Africa specifically to access health care services.

Gauteng Regulations that allowed hospitals to demand payment from patients are declared invalid.









Section 27(1)(a) of the Constitution says that everyone is entitled to access free health care services, which includes reproductive health care.





Hospitals and clinics may not ask pregnant and lactating women, and children under six to go through a fee classification and determination process.
